Canoe Gear List

Please call us if you are missing any items from the list, there is a good chance we can loan you items.

Required

Favorite Tent if you have one, If not we will provide

Sleeping Bag (rated for 20 degrees or cooler)

Inflatable pad or foam pad

Rain gear: pants and jacket (no ponchos) FrogToggs are an economical option

Hat with brim

Wool hat for cool mornings

Gloves (to stop blisters)

Sunglasses

Flashlight

Light wool shirt/jacket or sweater

Drinking water bottle

Two complete changes of clothing, including long pants and shirt quick drying fabrics are best

One set of long underwear (tops/bottoms, no cotton)

Shoes you don't mind getting wet (crocs, water shoes, old sneakers etc..)

Favorite boots or sneakers for light hiking

Personal toilet articles (incl. Toilet paper)

Eyeglasses (bring safety straps)

Personal medications, as needed for ALL Classes and trips

Cup with handle (for hot & cold)

Small backpack or small dry bag (for rain gear/water bottle/anything you want quick access to)

Suggested

Wild edibles I.D. book (Newcomb's Wild Flower Guide is great, optional)

Wash cloth/towel/bathing suit

Sunscreen lotion (SPF 15)

Favorite canoe paddle, if preferred

Favorite Life Jacket, if you do not have one we will provide

Insect repellent

Camera and film; spare batteries (optional)

Fishing gear and license (if you choose)

Sharp knife with locking blade not more than 4"

Small note pad & pencil

We will give you a large dry bag when you arrive to pack all of your gear in. If you own one and want to bring it please go ahead.
